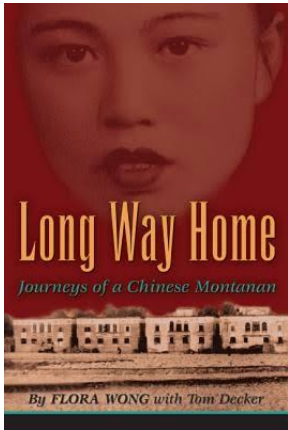


December 11th *What Happens in Montana* by Kim McCollum. Novel about a group of friends who visit a haunted resort in Montana.

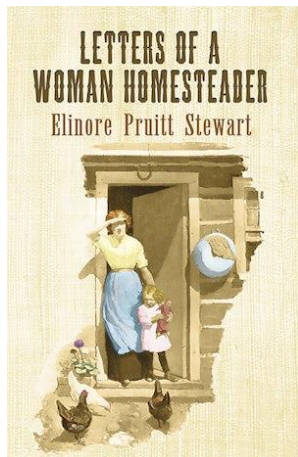

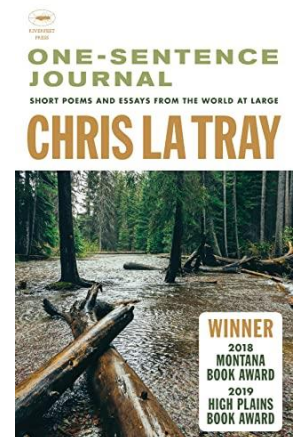
January 8th *The Lost Journals of Sacajewea* by Debra Magpie Earling.
